

## IMITATION GAME

### **Guidelines :**

1. Teams are allowed to choose any of the 2 sports given
2. Top 12 teams will be selected from the all the submission of round 1 (irrespective of the sports selected)
3. Selected 12 teams will be presenting the final submission during the fest in front of the jury

### **Eligibility:**

1. All students with a valid identity card of their respective educational institutions are eligible to participate.

### **Team Specifications:**

1. One team can have a maximum of 3 members.
2. Students from different institutes can be in the same team.

### **Certificate Policy & Prizes :**

1. Certificate of Excellence will be awarded to the top 3 teams participating in the competition.
2. Certificates of Participation will be given to all the teams that are selected.
3. All the participants of these 3 teams will be shortlisted for an Intern in Sportz Interactive
4. From 3 to 6 participants would be selected for this summer intern program with the stipend of 10k/month
5. The teams which get disqualified for disobeying any of the competition rules will not be considered for any certificate and internship.

1. The abstract must be submitted in pdf format only
2. Font: Verdana
3. Size: 11
4. Spacing between two lines: 0.6 inches
5. Spacing between two paragraphs: 1 inch
6. Bottom margin: 1 inch
